- **1.** National Board of Examination (NBE) provides reservation for 'in service' Doctors of ESI System (ESIC / ESIS) in Post Diploma DNB courses to be run/being run in ESIC Institutions.
- 2. The seat matrix for the Academic year 2025-26 in various ESIC Hospitals for 'in- service' doctors of ESI System ESIC / ESIS is as under:

- **3.** The above seats are subject to change as per the directions of NBE.
- **4.** All eligible ESIC / ESIS doctors who have qualified DNB PDCET 2025 and are desirous to pursue DNB course in the subjects as above may apply to ESIC Headquarters office through the proper channel by uploading the application with supporting documents in the enclosed format duly countersigned by the Medical Superintendent / DM(D) / DM(N) / Competent authority (Annexure-1) as a single pdf document duly attested on all pages and send it to at mecell.hq@esic.nic.in only Applications sent to other emails will not be considered.
- 5. ESIC doctors should send the application from the official ESIC email id

(xxxxxx.esic.nic.in/esic.gov.in) only. Forms received from other emails will not be considered.

6. Reservation:

- **6.1** Attested copy of Community Status Certificate in the prescribed form in case of candidates belonging to SC / ST / OBC / PWD / EWS category.
- **6.2** Candidates seeking reservation benefits under SC / ST / OBC / PWD / EWS category must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility prescribed in the Notice and as per the instruction issued by Govt. of India. They should also be in possession of the certificates in the prescribed format of Govt. of India in support of their claim.
- **6.3** Candidates claiming reservation under OBC Category should submit the OBC Certificate as per the prescribed format vide Govt. of India, Department of Personal and Training OM No. 36012/22/93- Estt.(SCT) dated 15.11.93 along with Self Declaration failing which the benefit of reservation will not be given.
- **6.4** The closing date for receipt of application will be treated as the date of reckoning for OBC status of the candidate and also, for assuming that the candidate does not fall in the creamy layer.
- **6.5** Candidates claiming reservation under EWS Category should submit the EWS Certificate in the prescribed format as per the Government of India.
- **7.** The applications should positively be received at the given emails by 5:30 Pm on 09.06.2025.
- **8.** Candidates (in-service) desiring to pursue Post Diploma DNB course would be required to obtain sanction of leave for study purpose from their organization, i.e. (i) Study leave or (ii) EOL for study purposes as per already laid-down procedure. It is therefore advised that only candidates who are eligible for grant of leave for study purpose and have qualified DNB PDCET 2025 may apply for DNB seats as above. The cut-off date for determining the eligibility of the candidate for grant of leave for study purpose would be 02.06.2025, i.e. date of issue of notice on ESIC website.
- **9.** Seats would be filled up as per policy and procedures as in Annexure-2.

- The applications received would be listed in order of merit and allotment of seats would be done based on choice / availability, by a committee constituted by DG-ESIC.
- 2. An individual department has been considered as the base unit to calculate the number of seats to be reserved for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBC and EWS candidates.
- 3. 5% seats reserved for PWD candidates.
- 4. Seat allotment:
 - 4.1 Seats allotment will be done as per merit, preferences and available seats.
 - 4.2 Students have to submit preferences in requisite format.
 - 4.3 The option once exercised by the candidate will remain the same for all rounds hence the options cannot be changed under any circumstances.


4.4 First Round:

- 4.4.1 Candidate has to submit acceptance for the allotted seat after allotment.
- 4.4.2 If candidate doesn't submit acceptance for the seat, he/she will not be considered for any further round.
- 4.4.3 Subsequently, the candidate has to submit request for 'RETENTION OF SEAT' OR 'PARTICIPATION IN SECOND ROUND'.
- 4.4.4 If candidate opts for 'RETENTION OF SEAT', then the candidate and seat will not be considered in second round.
- 4.4.5 If candidate opts for 'PARTICIPATION IN SECOND ROUND', his / her seat allotted in first counselling will also be available in the pool for counselling. The seat will also be filled as per merit and preference of all the participating candidates.

4.5 Second Round:

- 4.5.1 Candidate has to submit acceptance after the allotment of seat.
- 4.5.2 If candidate doesn't submit acceptance for the seat, he / she

will not be considered for any further rounds if held.



- 5 Only 2 rounds will be conducted.
- 6 If time permits and seats are left un-allotted at the end of second round of counselling, then a 'MOP UP' round (No fresh options will be called for) may be held.

- 7 Candidates who are allotted seats in 1st and 2nd round will not be eligible for Mop Up round.
- 8 The final list of successful candidates allotted / joined would be conveyed to NBE etc. by respective hospitals for further necessary action.
- 9 Candidates (in-service) desiring to pursue DNB course would be required to obtain sanction for leave for study purpose, i.e. study leave or EOL for study purposes, as per already laid-down procedure. The candidates would have to comply with bond as applicable for 'leave for study purpose'. It is reiterated that candidates eligible for grant of leave for study purpose may only apply.

10 Stipend:

- 10.1 The candidates on EOL who joins the course would receive **stipend** subject to executing bond with parent organization (ESIS) at the time of grant of EOL or with ESIC, so as to render public service after completion of course, as under.
- a. DNB Post Diploma (2 years)

1 st year	₹75,000/- per month
2 nd year	₹80,000/- per month

11 **Tuition / other Fee**: All candidates would pay fees as under:

	Tuition fee	₹75,000/- annually
	Library fees	₹15,000/- annually
	Annual appraisal fees	₹15,000/- annually
Accommodation charges		₹20,000/- annually

- 11.1 **Tuition fees**: The tuition fees shall cover the cost incurred for accreditation, institutional DNB office, infrastructure and HR training, teaching & research expenses, guest lecture, thesis support, administrative support expenses.
- 11.2 **Library fee:** Library fees shall cover the provisions made by the hospital for subscription of journals and purchase of textbooks for DNB & FNB trainees.
- 11.3 Annual appraisal fees: The appraisal fees shall cover the arrangements made for the purpose of appraisal of trainees and examiner remuneration.

11.4 Accommodation charges: Electricity and other consumables can be charged on actual basis by the hospital depending upon institutional policy. The accommodation charges cannot be levied if the accredited hospital is not providing accommodation to DNB.
